

**A REPORT ON THE PROCEEDINGS OF STATE LEVEL NADRS WORKSHOP ON
19th March 2012**

UT of Daman Diu AND UT of Dadra & Nagar Haveli

NIC DD & DNH UT Units in association with Animal Husbandry Department successfully achieved the intended outcome of the state level workshop on National Animal Disease Reporting System (NADRS) organized on 19th March 2012 at Silvassa, Dadra & Nagar Haveli. The State Level Workshop was a combined workshop for UT of Daman & Diu AND UT of Dadra & Nagar Haveli. District and UT-level veterinary officers and officials dealing with animal surveillance and monitoring were sensitized about the NADRS project, its components, to implement NADRS and effectively utilize the ICT infrastructure provided under the project for reporting instances of animal diseases. Both the UTs have 6 locations system across the UTs.

The workshop had participation of senior officers from the Animal Husbandry Departments of Dadra Nagar Haveli, Daman and Diu UTs, NIC Coordinators and DIOs. NIC officers from UT Unit were also participated.

Shri Naveen Kumar, Technical Director and Dr. Vandana Khullar, SSA from NIC-Hqrs, New Delhi participated in the workshop and provided all the informative

guidance to the participants. Representative from vendor also participated in the workshop. The workshop provided a platform to around 25 participants to express viewpoints and interact with one another. NADRS brochures were distributed to all participants. The manuals were also distributed in soft copies on CD to all the participants.

Shri Utpal Mehta, In-charge SIO of DD & DNH and State Coordinator, DD welcomed the participants and elaborated the theme of the workshop.

The Secretary cum Director, Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, Shri Manoj Sahoo, IAS, inaugurated the workshop and addressed the participants. Shri Naveen Kumar and Dr. Vandana Khullar also gave presentations on Block level MIS and Workflow Applications and Centralized Scheme Monitoring System which were appreciated by the participants.
