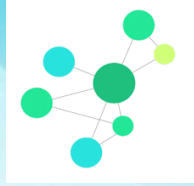

Installed IVFRT Client and VPN software as well as anti-virus in the office of IGP(Intelligence), Nagaland on **07-05-2021** for accessing the eFRO portal for checking the VISA extension application status and to keep track of the overstay of foreigners.

NDAL-ALIS is proposed to have a complete integrated arms license issuance system starting from the receipt of applications for arms licenses, document verification, application acceptance, police verification process, grant process and printing of license.
